How Do I Qualify For Home Repair?

- You must reside in the City limits of Morristown, Tennessee.
- You must reside in the home being repaired.
- City and County Property Taxes must be up to date.
- You must have an annual household income at or below

How Much Will I Have to Pay?

To make your home more comfortable and safe, assistance is available to qualified low income homeowners.

The City of Morristown Emergency Home Repair program offers “NO CHARGE” whatsoever for the services performed on one system (roof or electric or plumbing etc) up to \$5000.00.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

For emergency actions immediately necessary to safeguard against imminent danger to human life, health or safety, or to protect property from further structural damage (such as when a property has been damaged by a natural disaster, fire, or structural collapse).
